6. will submit a transcript of her first semester Grade 12 marks plus a copy of a midterm second semester report card of 40S courses and any other 40 level courses.
7. will submit letters of reference from two teachers and/or administrators to attest to her character and ability.
8. will submit a letter of no more than one type-written page, double spaced, explaining her choice of education/child care as a career.
9. will provide mailing address, telephone number and email address so the applicant can be reached if further information is required.
10. will provide a listing of extracurricular activities, work experience, and community service.
11. will provide a recent photo attached to the application for the Sorority's records.
